CONSIGNMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

relationship between the parties is that of Consignor and Consignee.

2. The Consignor agrees and covenants as follows:

- _____ a) At all times the consignment items remain at the risk of the Consignor, notwithstanding delivery to the Consignee. The Consignee is not responsible for loss or damage to items due to, but not limited to, fire, water, vandalism, theft or negligent handling by customers.
- _____ b) The Consignor agrees that the Consignee is entitled to a sales commission of ___% of the sale price of the item. Consignor agrees to reimburse Canadian Industrial & Farm Auctions for any of out-of-pocket expenses (fuel, minor repairs, clean up) incurred by the Consignee, to a maximum limit of \$150 without prior approval.
- _____ c) The Consignor acknowledges that all consignment items will be placed in a “non-reserve” sale designation and sold at auction by the Consignee. All consignment items will be sold to the highest bidder, with no price guarantee from either party.
- _____ d) This agreement covers the items listed on the Consignment List, (hereafter referred to as the consignment item (s)) or attached list. All items are sold as-is, where-is. Canadian Industrial & Farm Auctions accepts items and descriptions as accurate and true. In the case of an abortive sale due to misinformation by the consignor, the bidder’s payment will be waived and the consignor must take their item back from the sale within (14) days without funds due to them, and a fee of 15% of the item’s selling price will apply to a maximum of \$100.00.
- _____ e) The Consignor will not interfere with the integrity of the auction sale in any manner whatsoever. In particular, the Consignor, his agents and employees shall not bid upon the consignment items at any time. If at any time during the auction a consignor is caught bidding on their own items a 20% buyer and seller premium to a maximum of \$200.00 will apply and the consignor may be banned from future sales with Canadian Industrial & Farm Auctions.
- _____ f) The Consignor acknowledges that the sale proceeds for the consignment items will be co-mingled with other auction proceeds prior to payment, and that payment may be paid later than (7) days following the auction, or not at all if the items purchased have not been paid for by the buyer/high bidder.
- _____ g) In the event of an abortive sale, the consignment items must be returned at the discretion of the Consignee. Un-sold items must be retrieved, by the Consignor, within 14 days of email notification, failing which the consignment items shall become the property of the Consignee and may be disposed of by it as the Consignee sees fit.
- _____ (h) Auction lots are accepted on an appointment basis, in contact/calling order. Canadian Industrial & Farm Auctions may set a limit on how many items may be in a sale. If a consignor has items that are above stated limit that they would like to consign, Canadian Industrial & Farm Auctions reserves the right to allocate any lot(s) to a future sale. Alternatively, if the sale as not begun. the consignor is able to take their item back.

3. The Consignee agrees and covenants as follows:

- a) The Consignee will receive the consignment items on an “as is” basis and sell them at auction. The format, date and content of the auction is within the sole discretion of the Consignee.
- b) The Consignee will mail the net proceeds of sale to the Consignor within (14) days of the completed sale, subject to payment from the buyer of the equipment consigned/sold.
